Plan Check Professional: Bachelor's degree in structural, architectural or civil engineering; and three (3) years of experience performing structural, architectural, or civil engineering building design, review or inspection work related to building code compliance. A Master's degree in engineering or architecture may substitute for one year of work experience.

Registration in the State of California as a Civil or Structural Engineer or Architect is required. ICC Certification as a Plans Examiner or equivalent certification from a recognized agency is required within six months of date of hire.

Plans Examiner: High school diploma or equivalent with some college coursework in architecture, mathematics, construction technology, or related courses and either a:

Minimum of five (5) years of experience as a contractor, engineer, architect, superintendent, foreman or competent mechanic in charge of construction or a minimum of five (5) years of experience in plan checking, building inspection or related field.

ICC Certification as a Plans Examiner or equivalent certification from a recognized agency is required within one year of date of hire.
